[Tekcetera](#) has weathered the shrinking economy through 10 years in business and aims to give back by doing something charitable each month for 10 months.

The Santa Ana-based technology services company with about 14 employees is celebrating its 10-year anniversary in November and for 10 months prior is planning various ways to give back.

"Doing anything is the first step," said president and founder John Pitts. "Not doing anything is just that – not doing anything. You don't have to be a hundred-employee company to make an impact."

On Feb. 22 the company delivered toys to children with cancer at CHOC Children's and is slated to serve food at the [Someone Cares Soup Kitchen](#) this week.

Here's the full list of plans for each month:

- ▶ February: Tekcetera team to visit children with cancer at CHOC; deliver toys – Completed
- ▶ March: Tekcetera team to serve food at Someone Cares Soup Kitchen
- ▶ April: Volunteer in a park's revitalization project on Earth Day (April 22)
- ▶ May: Volunteer with a veterans program
- ▶ June: World Ocean's Day – Participate in a beach clean-up effort
- ▶ July: Monetary donation to a local nonprofit (\$1,000)
- ▶ August: Tekcetera to offer free services to a local nonprofit to help it save money and improve efficiencies
- ▶ September: Patriot's Day – Tekcetera team to work with military support group to send care packages to troops overseas
- ▶ October: Lead a computer training session for homeless/unemployed as part of a local workforce readiness training program
- ▶ November: Host electronics drive to make a donation to a local Orange County Goodwill
