The initiative will begin this month with a toy drive to benefit children with cancer. During the week of Feb. 20, Tekcetera will deliver toys to children at local hospitals. The final event will be a reception to conclude the program around Thanksgiving.

On top of the toy drive, other possible events over the next ten months will include serving food at local shelters, participating in beach clean-up efforts, sending care packages to military troops and hosting free computer-training workshops.
